Between fifteen and twenty people enjoyed the "Metal Working in Springwater, Past and Present" program at the Springwater Webster Crossing Historical Society Meeting on Tuesday evening March 26, 2019. After a delicious supper, President Donna Walker led the annual meeting at which two new members of the Board were voted into the Society: Mary Weed and Jordan Humphrey, each being present. Items of metal from the 1800's to the present were displayed. Some Humphrey items like a large copper kettle, iron cookware, a sheep bell, a cow bell, and a school bell were among the items. In the audience, Pat Willsea brought an old chicken catcher and two old hair curling irons that were heated on a wood stove, one for crimping the hair; Pat Auhinger brought an example of copper tin punch that her daughter made in 4-H over 30 years ago, and Don LoFurno brought one of the 150 poppies about 3 feet high that will be for the Poppy Project in Mount Morris to honor our veterans. At the Charles G. May Center in Mount Morris, the volunteers are cutting petals using a laser cutter, are welding them together, and adhering color. The poppies will be turning in the wind on a donated piece of property.
