This past Sunday, December 19, 14 hikers enjoyed the hike at the Harriet Hollister Spencer Recreation Area. beauty of the hike. The hike coming up on December 26th is when the group encourages everyone to hike with their family and to plan to attend Springwater Trail's First Day Hike on Saturday, January 1, 2022 starting at 10 AM at the north end of Canadice Lake at the Parking area off Purcell Hill Road. Masks are required during the initial meet up; sensible choice and social distancing are recommended for the remainder of the hike. The approximate distance is up to 5 miles, the guided hike will be 3.6 miles. This is an easy, 1.8-mile each way hike along the shore of the lake; the trail is level and well-maintained and the lake views are lovely. For most hikers it will be a walk along the lake for an hour, and then back the same way; more enthusiastic hikers can veer off on Rob's Trail that leads over the ridge and down to Hemlock Lake - a moderate to hard trail with several steep uphill and downhill sections.
