Pat Hillyard said Fire Department will be holding a Comedy Night and Steak Dinner fundraiser but she did not have the dates. Terri White assured her that date could be handwritten on the calendar when the date is firm.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: Rob Parker announced that the next prayer service is scheduled on Thursday night, February 18 – changed to this date after discovering Town Board met on 2/16/2016 and all residents were invited to an informational meeting regarding Water and Sewer issues. Prayer service will be held at the Webster Crossing UMC at 7:00 PM.

March service will be held at the Lighthouse Wesleyan Church on March 15, 2016. All are welcome.

FARMS: No farm report.

Question was asked about events beyond December 31, 2016, and Judy stated Jim and Pat Clark may open their sugar bush maple farm on Wheaton Hill for tours in 2017.

Arts & Craft Show – Diane Olson indicated all is under control for this event. She also reminded people that posters need to be alike as a possible branding item for events in the future.

GALA – No comments were made regarding the GALA except that the Bicentennial part on Saturday is under control. Fire department will have events; Atlanta-Cohocton Historical group is pending an okay to hold an old-fashioned fashion show; possible Duck Race by SFD; water ball; possible 1930s tour car to be displayed; children's events, etc.

Pre-Valentine's Day Dinner & Dance – Gemini is booked; dinner is planned, posters are up and tickets are now at the Legion and available for purchase.

Square Dance – John Kerr is interested in holding square dance at Fire Hall, but likes the floor at the Post. Would like he and his wife Colleen Liggett to hold musical events on a regular basis. Dan LoFurno said Music Festival Committee is probably holding square dance under their sponsorship at the "Barn" on Miller property as part of Music Festival in September. John stated dates are filling up on SFD's calendar.

Music Festival and All American Arts & Crafts Weekend – Dan LoFurno was there and gave no report except plans are coming along.

Fire Department –Judy reported SFD has copy of calendar and plans to meet with her and Terri regarding pending events. Rick Tripp, Jr., is working with Civil War Re-enactor's group and at this time the group is still working on 2016 schedule.

Founder's Day – Invitations are out and will await RSVPs. Senator Young has responded positively and proto-type of proclamation has been forwarded so her staff can complete it.

Judy told a story about how, after the proclamation was forwarded to Albany, the 5x great grandson of John Roberts notified her that his family would like to participate. John Roberts formally suggested the name of this town in 1817, and his family members will be here for Memorial Day, GALA and Fall Festival as well as Founder's Day.

Steve Cowley said he is trying to line up money for music at GALA but most bands are booked and we do not have a lot of funding. He also asked about tent rental for August Revival and Rob Parker responded that the participating churches will probably take care of any expense for it.

He shared with all of us a picture of the three signs the town agreed to pay for at the Town Board meeting on Monday, February 1, 2016, for advertising the Bicentennial. Two will be prominently displayed in town and one will be portable to be placed where functions are occurring during the Bicentennial.

Judy and Terri shared the conversation they had last week with Supervisor Babbitt-Henry in which she told about possible landscaping on SW corner of four corners, upgrading the Larry Canute Memorial Pak and possibly buying a two-sided LED computer-programmable sign for the town on a state bid.

Judy also shared that a semi-pro baseball team has expressed interest in the Old-fashioned Baseball Game exhibition on July 3, 2016 in the park.
