The difference between the two programs is that Food Link food is open to anyone, whereas the Food Pantry food is for those having a special need for it. Donations to Food Link are made primarily by the large food vendors, while donations to the Food Pantry are made by the people right in our community who wish to share what they have with those less fortunate.
