Young people who might want to work on the tree farm should call 585-669-2659 between March 15 and 30, to set up a time for an interview. If you know someone who is between the ages of 14 and 16 that likes to work outdoors, let them know about this opportunity to enjoy teamwork, work with their hands during the growing season, learn tree farming skills, and see the results of their hard work during the selling season. Although other tree farms may be closed already for the season, All Western Evergreen Farm will be open this weekend, Friday, December 18 from 3 to dark; Saturday, December 19 from 9 AM to dark and Sunday, December 20, from 11 AM to dark. Anyone desiring wreaths, garland, centerpieces, kissing balls, or mail box huggies should call 585-669-2659 ahead of time to check on availability.
